Bible Passages: Luke 15:11-14, 17-24 Discussion Questions: à What was your most memorable experience of being lost on an outing or a journey? à When did you recognize your need for God's forgiveness for your sin? à What does it look like for us to turn to God? Food for thought: We've all lost something. We lost the car keys; we lost the car keys. For television, and we lost the road traveling for a destination. But the loss is much more common in another way; We are all hopeless lost in relation to God. We are so lost, we cannot find our way back to God God Mine. However, God did what we could never do. Through Christ, God has opened the way to all who repent and believe in Christ to return to Him. In Luke 15, a young son thought he knew where he wanted to go. It was a destination framed with sumptuous life and concentrated around money. The good life was waiting for him. Or at least he thought so. To those who listen to this parable first, the son's request for "the share of the heritage that I have got" (v. 12) was a shocking request. He had no right to any inheritance while his father was still alive. It was like wishing your father was dead, so he could have what he thought he deserved. His father kindly answered his request and gave his younger son his share. With his hand, the youngest son "reported all his possessions and left for a distant country" (v. 13). Those who read the trilogy of J.R.R. Tolkien, "The Lord of the Rings", know the phrase: "Not all who wander are lost." It's a good feeling for the Hobbits, but when it comes to our whole life, we don't just have to wander through life. Without intention and purpose rooted in Christ, we do more than wander. We're lost. The youngest son came to that same awareness of being lost. "He returned to himself" (v. 17). In the end, he decided to go home and look for work in the father's land as a servant. But when his father saw his son from afar, it was as if he was looking at him anxiously. He was full of compassion. His love for the prodigal son was so intense that he abandoned all fatherly dignity and ran from his son. For the rebel son, the shock of his father's action could only be overcome by his words. The father made a party because the son he believed dead had returned home. When we wake up from our sin and return to the Father, He is ready to welcome us with open arms. His welcome has nothing to do with the wealth, skills or results we affirm as goods. We're as indigenous as the prodigal son. At the same time, no amount of rebellion or sin in the "far off land" (Luke 15:13) diminishes the love and embrace of our heavenly Father. In Christ we are offered forgiveness and new life.
